

# E-mail quote

Printers Website can allow customers to e-mail themselves a copy of the quote they have created on your website – even if they are not logged in. This quote will also contain introductory text, which can be modified.

## Enabling the option on the Admin page

To enable this option, click “Product Page Settings” on your main admin page. This will open the “Product info page Settings” page.

Click “edit” for the option, and choose to either enable or disable the option. Click “Submit” to save your changes.

## Modifying the e-mail text

To modify the text of the e-mail that is sent, click “Manage emails” from your main admin page. Then, click “edit” for “Price quote from XYZ Printing”.

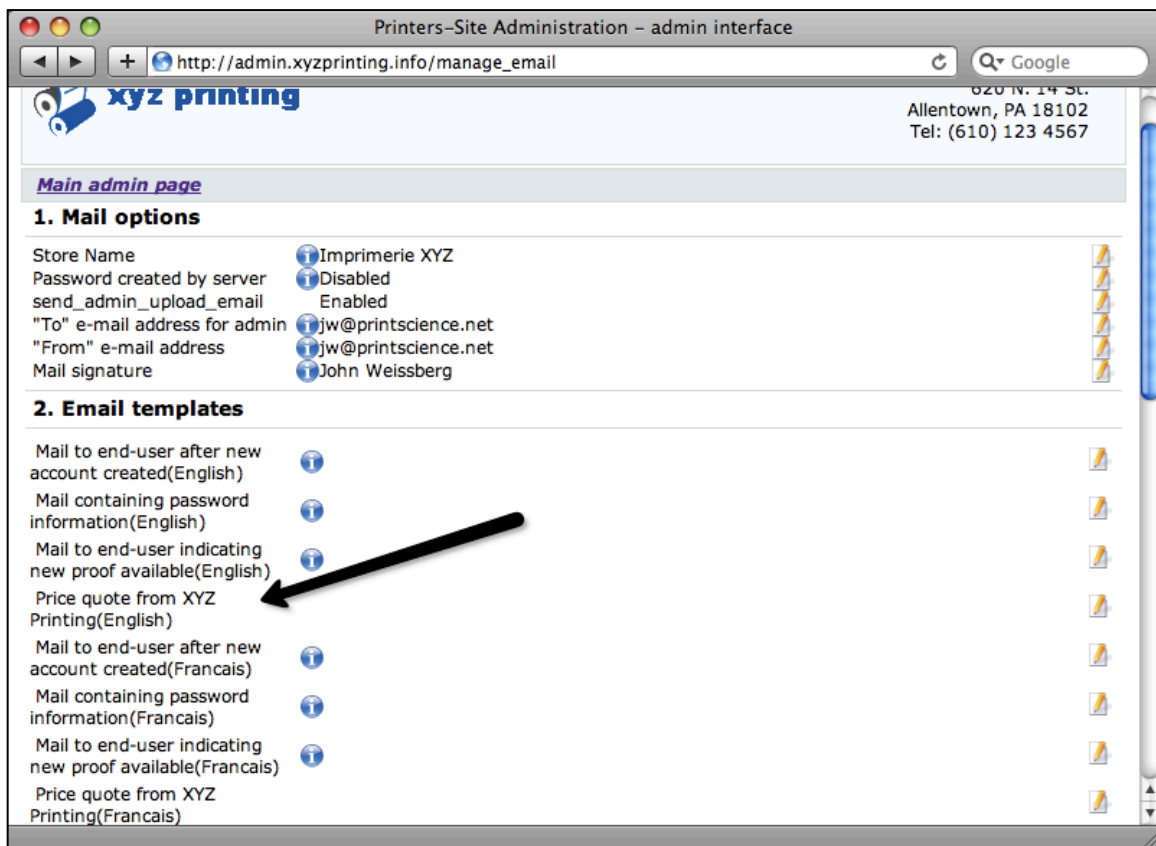


Figure 3: Price quote email under “Manage Emails”.

After you click “edit” for the email template, you can change the subject of the e-mail, as well as the body text that is displayed before the actual quote.

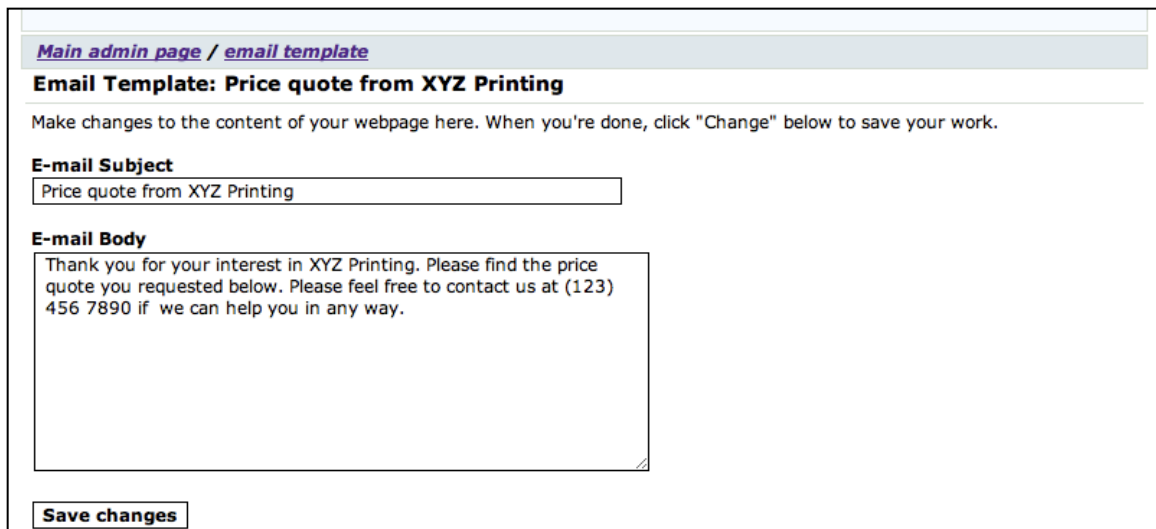


Figure 4: Editing the Price quote e-mail.

To save changes made to the e-mail subject or body, click “Save changes”.

## Using the option on the customer page

Once this is enabled, customers can send themselves a quote of the product they have configured. To do this, customers can configure the product as they normally would.

After configuring their product, the customer simply enters their e-address in the text field at the bottom of the page, and clicks “E-mail this quote”.

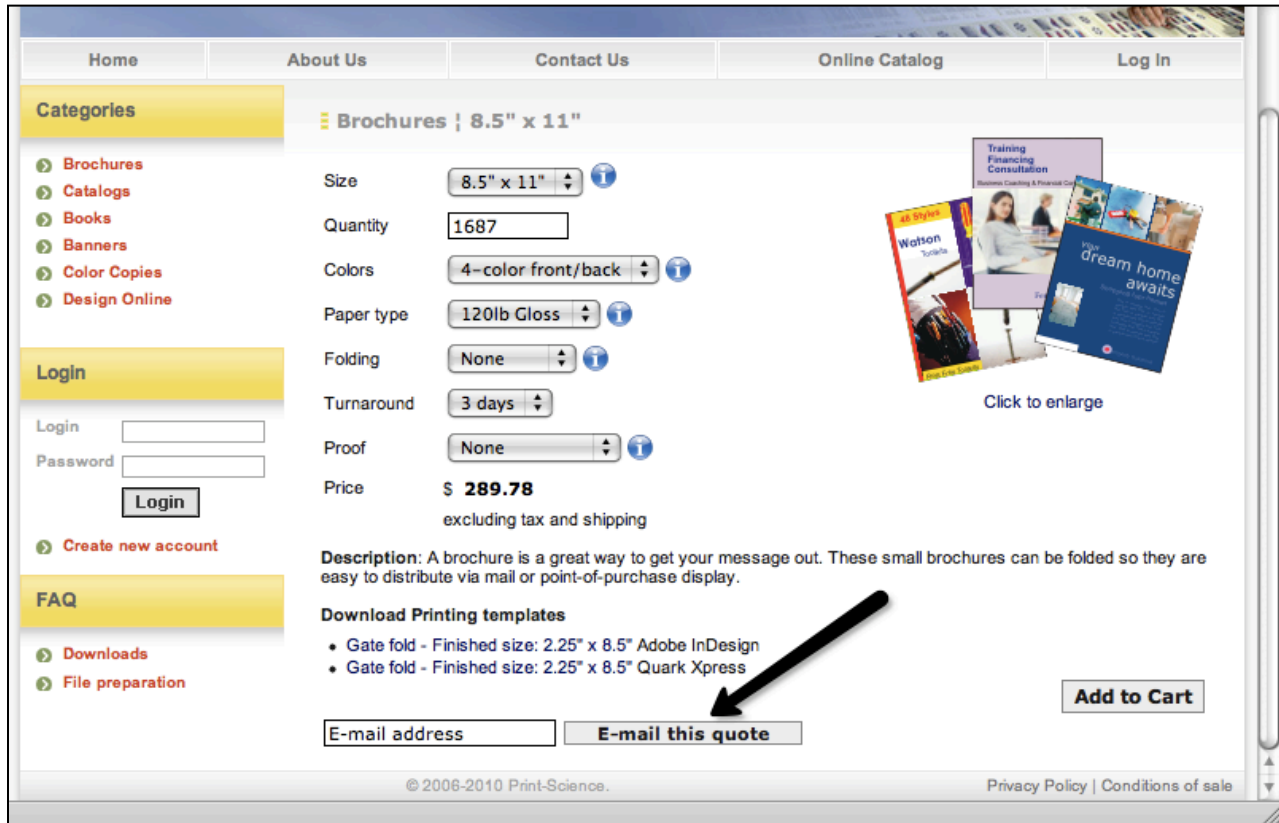


Figure 5: Product configuration page with the “E-mail this quote” button.

After the customer clicks the “E-mail this quote” button, confirmation text will appear, reading “We have mailed a quotation to you”.

The customer will receive an email similar to the one below.
